

ALLAN KLEARMAN - This 57 year old gentleman had colon cancer which was surgically removed, but still metastasized to the liver. He had 28 walnut-sized lesions in his liver and his prognosis was a couple months to live. Immediately after DEAN'S initial treatments, Allan's CEA cancer count, which was well above normal, became normal. After a few months of treatment by DEAN KRAFT, not only did the man feel great physically, mentally and emotionally, but his CT scan now showed that half the tumors in the liver disappeared and the rest got smaller by 50%. All through this time, all of Allan's blood tumor marker counts have been normal. DEAN KRAFT was the only treatment Allan underwent.

During this time that Allan was doing well, his doctors talked him into putting a chemical pump in his liver in an attempt to give chemotherapy preventatively, even though his counts were normal. Unfortunately, this pump hemorrhaged inside him, putting him into a coma with his lungs and kidneys failing. By the time DEAN KRAFT arrived at the St. Louis Hospital to administer "laying-on-of-hands", in front of his wife and children, this physician said that Allan would not get out of this coma. But within five minutes, DEAN had Allan up from the coma, responding to his commands, sticking out his tongue, moving his hands and feet in front of the family.

Interestingly enough, three other people in the same Intensive Care cubicle also got out of their comas at the same time.

As of January 1993, Allan is well and on his way to a full remission. (see attached letter)- x-rays and reports on file).
