Dear Mr. Kraft.

I am very sorry to have been out of touch for so long. I have not been home much, and somehow neglected to tell you the great news.

While I was seeing you, I think I told you this, my doctor anoticed the character of my wound had changed, and it seemed to be healing in a different way than before.

About two weeks after my last visit(four visits in all), we thought it had closed, but that was premature. It opened again, yet still I was hopeful because things were happening.

Then, within another month, it was closed again, and looked good. Every week my doctor checked it, and it stayed closed. Now it has been healed six weeks, and there is really no reason to think it will open without provocation.

I cannot explain how I feel. My doctor never knew I saw you, because he's put so many years into this foot I didn't want the moment of final healing to be a matter of discussion. I believe it was a combination. But there is no doubt that from the time you first helped me, within 12 weeks or less my foot healed-and this comes after we had waited for this wound to close for three years, and for the entire foot to recover from the original injury for nine.

Thank you so much for your part in my recovery. I'll come by sometime to show you how it looks, and express my thanks in person.
